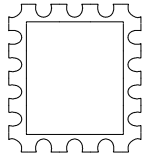

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

By volunteering at TALGV, you can use your own unique talents, skills and interests to help the animals. Listed below are some of the ways you can share your expertise. Although, if you think of another way to help, please let us know. Whatever you can provide is appreciated. It's all about the animals.

ANIMALS

Pet Pals — Clean kennels, love, feed, groom and exercise the animals (3 hour shift)
Foster Caregivers — Provide temporary shelter for animals in their homes while the pet awaits adoption
Pet Therapy Facilitators — Take pets to visit residents in assisted care facilities (certification classes required)
Benefactor Club Members — Finance the care and adoption of special needs animals

COMMUNITY

Project Developers — Organize and implement special projects designed to help enhance our ability to serve our animal friends
Fund Raisers — Organize TALGV's participation at local events such as carnivals, fairs, craft shows, etc.
Publicists — Compose articles for the newspaper, the TALGV website and the *Paw Prints* newsletter; develop flyers and other media for events
Webmaster Assistants — Assist the webmaster in the updating of the website: www.talgv.org
Photographers — Take photos of TALGV events and animals available for adoption

OFFICE & FACILITY

Administrative Positions — Serve as secretaries, receptionists, record keepers and other support positions in the office
Lost/Found Coordination Assistants — Help in the recovery and return of lost animals
Adoption Coordination Assistants — Maintain a list of available pets and persons wanting pets and assist in the adoption process
Handypersons — Assist in maintenance of the TALGV facility
Gardeners — Maintain the grounds

THRIFT SHOP

Thrift Store Clerks — Work as salespeople in the ATTIC (3 hour shift)
Donation Sorters — Sort and price donated items (3 hour shift)
Donation Testers — Check small electronics, appliances and computers
Muscle Persons — Move larger items
